



## **FOOTBALL CANADA COACH MENTORSHIP PROGRAM AT 2017 INTERNATIONAL BOWL**

### **OVERVIEW**

Football Canada is seeking to fill two apprentice coach positions – one position on each Canadian national team as part of the 2018 International Bowl series.

#### **Membership Requirements**

Coaches must be members of Football Canada through their provincial governing body in order to be considered for this opportunity.

#### **Time Commitment:**

Approximately ten days in January. This year's event's dates are January 11th to January 20th 2018.

### **GOALS**

1. Provide opportunities for developing coaches interested in high performance coaching.
2. Provide developing coaches with high level mentorship.
3. Provide international competition experience.
4. Experience in tournament style competition.

### **TARGET**

Football Canada will select one apprentice coach from the pool of candidates for each of the streams below.

**Stream A:** Current high school or club coaches that are looking to develop their coaching skills through NCCP training and any other in-class and on-field training opportunities.

#### **Qualifications:**

- Completion of Making Head Way in Football e-learning module
- Safe Contact trained
- Trained position coach at the NCCP Competition-Introduction context

**Stream B:** Coaches at an elite level (e.g. AFL, CEGEP, QJFL or CJFL) or have participated as an elite athlete, wanting to become a coach at the national level through the participation in NCCP training and any other in-class or on-field training programs.

Qualifications:

- Completion of Making Head Way in Football e-learning module
- Safe Contact trained
- Completion of Making Ethical Decisions (MED) online evaluation
- In-training at the NCCP Competition-Development context

## 2018 INTERNATIONAL BOWL SERIES

- Apprentice coaches to be assigned to one of the participating national teams.
- Apprentice will participate in all of their assigned team’s meetings and practices as an observer.
- Apprentice to create a practice plan each day for a specific position, and provide a copy to one of the National Team Coaches for review and feedback.
- Apprentice to sit in on all end of day national team coaches meetings after their team meetings and provide national team coaches with summary of their day.
- Apprentice to sit with national team coach on final day during evaluations.

## APPLICATION PROCESS

Applicants are asked to submit their resume, NCCP transcript, and two letters of recommendation (including one from a current superior on the team they currently coach) to their provincial governing body at the coordinates below.

Based on the received applications, PSOs are asked to submit the name and resumes of two candidates – one for each stream for consideration to Football Canada. Applications directly from candidates to Football Canada will NOT be considered.
